### ENTRIES:

All entries are to be electronically entered into SLSSA **Event Management System**.

*At this time of year some clubs may have trouble entering competitors into the EMS. This is most like because the system has been set by Surf Life Saving Australia to the 2015/16 season. Therefore if club members are not yet registered for the new season (i.e. club rego day has not yet happened) they will not come up in the EMS.*

### RESULTS

Results in this event are not counted toward any season trophies or point scores but do form part of the State Team and Development Team Selection process.

### COMPETITION CONDITIONS:

Events will be conducted in accordance with the Surf Sports Manual – 34<sup>th</sup> Edition and associated Bulletins issued by Surf Life Saving Australia from time to time. All competitors must be proficient and financial and be the holder of the appropriate award.

### EVENTS:

Should numbers be sufficient, all age categories will be conducted:

Sprint and flags for U/13, U/14, U/15, U/17, U/19, Open and Masters M&F.

Masters categories will be sorted according to the nominations received (e.g. 30-39 etc if nominations warrant it).

Relays will be conducted if time permits.

**CONTINGENCY PLAN:**

Should, at any stage prior to or during competition, there is a credible basis for concluding there is an unreasonable risk of serious injury occurring, the Carnival Committee and / or appropriate officials shall suspend all or parts of the competition. The Carnival Committee and / or appropriate officials shall then decide whether to postpone, cancel or relocate all or parts of the competition.

Should a risk assessment indicate that part, or all of the competition, not be conducted because of adverse beach, weather or surf conditions, or another threat, the Carnival Committees and / or appropriate officials will again decide whether to postpone or cancel all or parts of the competition.
