The **ILS Lifesaving World Championships** are conducted every 2 years, showcasing excellence in lifesaving sports and rescue; attracting the most talented and skilled lifesaving athletes to compete for the title of World's best. It is an opportunity to profile the Lifesaving Movement, the important role it plays as an emergency service and highlight our members' contribution to the community.

The lifesaving World Championships relies heavily on a dedicated team of volunteers who work behind the scenes to ensure the event is a success. Availability is being sought from SLSA Club members to be part of a dynamic volunteer workforce throughout the event to work both autonomously and in conjunction with ILS and LWC staff.

There will be opportunities in the following areas:

- **Administration Assistant** (phone and email queries, customer service, computer/office tasks)
- **Accreditation Assistant** (assembly of participant packs, verify registrations, customer service)
- **Workforce Welfare Assistant** (oversee volunteers, point of contact for volunteer queries etc.)
- **Media Assistant** (photography, social media, cataloguing images & video)
- **Greeters** (street team, meet & greet participants, help and assist with directions, traffic flow)
- **Hospitality Assistant** (cook & serve BBQ, distribution of lunches, serving food & drinks)
- **Operations Assistant** (work closely with LWC staff, set up/pack down, physical operation/logistics)
- **Driver** (driving guests between venues, recoding vehicle trips in logbook and refueling)
- **Marshal** (managing and maintaining foot/traffic in pool areas, beach areas & parking areas)

Volunteer services will be required from Monday 12th November up to and including Tuesday 4th December at Glenelg beach and the South Australian Aquatic and Leisure Centre at Marion. Shifts will be 0600-1100, 1100-1630, 1630-2200

Volunteers will receive a LWC2018 uniform, be provided with refreshments during shifts, and receive an invitation to the Volunteer Thank You function.

Additional Information

- No subsidies are available for volunteers travelling from interstate or overseas.
- 12 members per club would be a fantastic contribution for the event.
- Provide or obtain a working with children current police check.
- Attend compulsory training sessions to ensure familiarity with events protocols.
- Commit to and attend at least 3 shifts during the event delivery period.
- Agree to read, understand and be bound by Surf Life Saving SA policies and procedures.

All SLSA Club members are eligible to apply but must hold a working with children current police check.
