Entry Fees

The event entry fee is set at **\$40 (+ GST) per entered competitor**. *Please note that the entry fee covers any or all of the following Masters State Championship events: Champion Lifesaver, Masters Surf Boats, Masters Ocean/Beach events.*

Late entry fees are charged for any entries made after 10am on Tuesday 19/2/19 (for surf boat entries) and after 10am on Tuesday 26/2/19 (for ocean/beach entries) and before close of late entries (10am, Wednesdays 20 & 27 February 2019 respectively). This fee is set at the entry fee + 100% of entry fee (ie total \$80 + GST).

Clubs will be invoiced for all entered competitors (including any late entries) following the championships.

* Reserve active members = 8 hours; Clubs may recognise alternative voluntary service hours & if so, maximum 50% of the minimum required hours can be endorsed as service hours (requires formal endorsement by SLSC Club Board and subsequent advice to SLSSA). Life members & long service members are exempt from patrol hour obligations related to championships entry eligibility.
