## ELIGIBILITY & ENTRY

### Team Manager Information & Declaration

Clubs are to complete the [Team Manager information & declaration](#) by 12 noon on Wednesday 20 February. Information required includes names of allocated club officials.

### Entry Fees

The carnival entry fee, as for all SLSSA non-championship carnivals, is set at **\$12.50 (+ GST) per entered competitor**. Late entry fees are charged for any entries made after 10am on Thursday 21/2/19 and before close of late entries (10am, Friday 22/2/19). This fee is set at the entry fee + 100% of entry fee (ie total \$25 + GST).

Clubs will be invoiced for all entered competitors (including any late entries) following the carnival.

**Please note that the entry fee covers both Senior Water Carnival #4 & Senior Beach Carnival #4.**

### Eligibility

All eligibility criteria as detailed below MUST be achieved AND showing in Surfguard by the date of the close of entries (Thurs 13 December 2018).

<sup>1</sup> For Under 15 age category members, the award required is Surf Rescue Certificate and/or Bronze Medallion; Proficient is defined as the award expiry date being later than the date of close of entries for the relevant event

<sup>3</sup> For Under 17 age category members the basic assessment is the 400m pool swim (to be completed in <9minutes); for Under 15 age category members this is the 200m swim (to be completed in <5minutes). Other criteria apply (refer Use of SLSA Equipment Policy 1.02)
