### COVID-19 UPDATE – Semaphore SLSC

Dear Member

As you would be aware our Premier announced a 7-day lockdown effective at 6pm today in response to the current COVID 19 cases in our state.

This means we have entered Level 5 Stay at Home restrictions to minimise people's movements and to hopefully allow SA Health to get ahead of the current situation.

Level 5 restrictions allow only 5 reasons to leave home:

- Essential work
- To obtain essential goods and services
- Essential health services (including getting COVID testing or vaccination)
- Care and compassion grounds
- Exercise with those in your household.

As a result of the lockdown from 6pm today the Club will be closed to all members and the public. For security and safety members are also asked not to access the Club for any reason during this time.

The closure will remain in place until the restrictions are amended, at which time, we will assess the impact on our operations (both commercially and from a surf perspective) and advise members what it will mean for you. This will include any implications for the upcoming Quiz Night and AGM scheduled for the weekend of the 31 July.

As always, the safety and wellbeing of our members and the community is our number one priority so please stay safe during this time.
