2014-15 Champion Lifesaver State Championships Instructions and Nomination information

Nominations are now sought from clubs for the 2014-15 Champion Lifesaver State Championships to be conducted as per details below.

CATEGORIES: U14, U15, U17, U19, Open, Masters

PHYSICAL EVENTS: Saturday, 31st January 2015, **Grange SLSC**

Competition to start at approximately 10.00 am or as determined by Referee on the day (Vin Cobiac). Note that Champion Patrol practical will be conducted prior to this starting at approximately 8.00 a.m. so start time will be determined by number of entries.

THEORY / RESUS: Thursday 29th January 2015, **Surf Central**. Isolation closes: 6.00 pm.

This event will be conducted under the rules as provided in the 34th Edition of the Surf Sport Competition Manual. Competitors only will be permitted access to Isolation area; all other interested parties are to remain outside of the declared area until theory component has been completed.

Patrol Hours:

The patrol hour qualification for entry into the 2014-15 Champion Lifesaver State Championships is by the existing ruling (SLSA Policy 5.4). Members had until the 31st December 2014 to complete 16 hours or comply with relevant SLSA bulletins/circulars. Members not completing the hours will forfeit medals, points and render themselves unable to compete in other State Championship events in season 2014-15.

All competitors must be proficient and financial for season 2014-15 and be the holder of the appropriate award.

NEW ENTRY AND LATE ENTRY ARRANGEMENTS:

To come closer in line with Aussies and with enhanced use of on-line entries via Event Management System (EMS), we are now allowing a second late entry for State Championship events and have modified the initial late entry fee. This should also make it more flexible for clubs. Entries will now be:

- Close of entry via EMS to State Championships will remain as is (5.00 pm on the Friday a week prior to the event) **Friday 23rd January 2015**
- LATE ENTRY (electronic via EMS): close of late entry via EMS remains as is at 12.00 noon on the Tuesday prior to the event. The late fee is set at entry fee plus 100% of entry fee. **12.00 noon, Tuesday, 27th January 2015**



- **AFTER EMS LATE ENTRIES CLOSE:** This is new and entries may now be submitted after close of EMS provided they are received no later than 12.00 noon on the last working day before the event is scheduled to occur. The individual or team entries will be accepted via 'hard copy' as long as declarations of compliance with proficiency and patrol hour requirements and endorsements of Club are also provided. The fee is set at entry fee plus 200% of entry fee.
- **CHANGES TO EXISTING ENTRIES/ADDITIONAL EVENTS:** Changes to already existing entries can occur up until Late Entries via EMS. After this date, an admin fee of \$5.00 per change to an already existing competitor can occur up until 12.00 noon on the last working day before the event is scheduled to occur.

Entry Fees:

A **\$5.00** entry fee will be charged for entries received by close of nominations as above. (**Friday 23rd January 2015**)

Therefore late entries received by **12.00 noon, Tuesday, 27th January** will be **\$10.00**

Entries received post late EMS entry and prior to 12.00 pm on the past working day prior to the event will be **\$15.00**.

These will be accounted for through the clubs directly after the event.
