Nominations are now sought from Clubs for the 2017/18 Lifesaving State Championships this event will include;

- Champion Lifesaver
- Champion Patrol
- R & R
- First Aid

The Surf Sports Advisory Committee has elected to combine these events in to a single State Championship with a single entry free to encourage increased participation in Lifesaving competitions. Points attracted at this event will accrue in to an overall point score for the Senior State Championship.

Entries

Entries can be done via the on-line Event Management System (EMS) from 30 January 2018.

New Entry and Late Entry Arrangements

Close of entry via EMS to State Championships will remain as is (5.00pm on the Friday a week prior to the event) **Friday 9**th **February 2018**

LATE ENTRY (electronic via EMS): close of late entry via EMS remains as is at 12.00 noon on the Tuesday prior to the event. The late fee is set at entry fee plus 100% of entry fee. <u>12.00 noon, Tuesday 13th February 2018</u> No new entries will be accepted after the close of late entry EMS.

CHANGES TO EXISTING ENTRIES/ADDITIONAL EVENTS Changes to already existing entries can occur up until Late Entries via EMS. After this date, an admin fee of \$5.00 per change to an already existing competitor can occur up until 12.00 noon on the last working day before the event is scheduled to occur.

Eligibility

Eligibility for entry into the 2017/18 Champion Lifesaver State Championships is by the existing ruling (SLSA Policy 5.4). Members had until the 31st December 2017 to comply with the policy or relevant SLSA bulletins/circulars. Members not complying will forfeit medals, points and render themselves unable to compete in other State Championship events in season 2017/18.

All competitors must be proficient and financial for season 2017/18 and be the holder of the appropriate award. No exemptions will be granted for this event it is the Clubs responsibility to ensure that awards and proficiencies have been uploaded in to Surfguard, please allow 2 weeks for processing from the date of submission.

Entry Fees

A \$40.00 ex GST entry fee will be charged for entries received by close of nominations as above (Friday 9 February 2018)

Late Entries received by 12:00pm Tuesday 13 February will be charged at \$80.00 ex GST.

*Please note a single entry fee of \$40.00 per participants covers entries in to Champion Lifesaver, Champion Patrol and R&R, Junior R&R is included in Junior State Championships fees and attracts no cost.

Fees will be accounted for through the clubs directly after the event.
