The Anzac Eve Vigil is a State RSL conducted Vigil commencing at 6.00pm Anzac Eve Tuesday 24 April 2019 through to around 5.30am when the SA National War Memorial on North Terrace is handed over to the Dawn Service staff.

Volunteers will participate in a VIP attended Dedication Ceremony at 7.00pm Anzac Eve joined by the Governor of SA and other invited guests, then the Vigil will continue.

The Vigil involves SLSSA volunteers along with Army, Navy, SES, CFS, St John's, Scouts and many other volunteer organisations continuously rotating and standing around the memorial. SLSSA's volunteers are committed from 6.00pm until midnight.

Volunteers will be expected to wear their patrol tops and hats, plus long black pants. Patrol jackets may be useful in case of poor weather.

Supper is provided and from previous years those involved have found it a very meaningful event.
