CLUB CLOSURE UPDATE – Semaphore SLSC

Dear Member,

As you will be aware, the SA Government is moving towards opening up the economy, including gradually removing the current restrictions on licensed premises. I would like to assure you that the Board is actively monitoring the situation with a view to reopening the club when appropriate.

Whilst the club's Board has determined that under the current guidelines, enabling the club to serve meals for up to 10 patrons inside and 10 outside, it is not viable to reopen at present. Should the Government determine to further reduce these measures, which looks likely in coming days, then the club will look to reassessing when and how we can open. This decision will be made with members health and safety as our first priority but must also consider our financial viability.

In any event, when the opportunity to reopen occurs, there will be additional requirements we will need to comply with such as gathering capacity numbers and the continuation of social distancing. Coming to the club, like many public places will not be the same as it was before the close, so we ask for your support to comply with these measures (whatever they may be) and look forward to the opportunity of being together at the club.
