SLSSA is once again appealing to youth members aged 14-18 and adult supervisors to be involved in the ANZAC Eve Youth Vigil 2021. The ANZAC Eve Vigil is a State RSL conducted Vigil commencing on ANZAC Eve until 5:30am when the Dawn Service commences.

Despite the COVID-19 interruption last year, SLSSA has proudly been involved in the Vigil since 2006.

The commitment:

- **Drill rehearsal Sunday 11th April 11:00am – 1:30pm**, Torrens Parade Ground (compulsory)
This includes a barbecue lunch.
- **ANZAC Vigil, Saturday 24th April 5:30pm – 12:00am**, SA National War Memorial (corner North Tce & Kintore Ave)
- **RSVP for rehearsal by 10:00m Wednesday 7th April**

Who is required:

- 2 – 10 youth members (female and male)
- 1 supervising adult at all times

The Vigil involves SLSSA volunteers along with Army, Navy, SES, CFS, St John's, Scouts and many other volunteer organisations continuously rotating and holding vigil around the War Memorial. SLSSA's volunteers are committed from 6.00pm until midnight.

Volunteers will be expected to wear their patrol tops and hats, plus long black pants. Patrol jackets may be useful in case of poor weather.

Due to ongoing COVID-19 restrictions, there will be no Dedication Ceremony this year. Instead, an informal ceremony will be attended by the Governor of South Australia, President of the RSL SA, the Premier and Leader of the Opposition. Those involved previously have found it a very meaningful event.
